

Postgraduate study for allied health professionals (AHPs) working in rural SA

Two graduate training options: Level 1 program for AHPs with 1-2 years experience Level 2 Graduate Diploma/ Master of RGP for AHPs with 2-5 years experience

- Limited funded regional Local Health Network trainee positions
- Centrally coordinated through Rural Support Service
- Externally evaluated through Flinders University
- Non-government/private trainee positions funded through <u>TAHRGETS</u>

Aim: "improve health outcomes for rural and remote consumers through increasing access to a highly skilled allied health workforce, and enhancing opportunities for multidisciplinary care in rural healthcare teams"
