*Are you a Rural GP working in South Australia, and would like to upskill and become a GP Obstetrician?*

The Rural Generalist Program South Australia (RGPSA) and the Rural Doctors Workforce Agency (RDWA) in partnership with Northern Adelaide Local Health Network (NALHN) have created up to two GP / GP Obstetric training roles at the Lyell McEwin Hospital, NALHN.

These positions will allow you to undertake your GP Obstetrics training either working full-time over 12 months or part-time over 2 years while continuing to work part-time as a rural General Practitioner.

As a Fellowed rural GP or a GP on a pathway to Fellowship you will be employed by NALHN at Senior Registrar level as per the Salaried Medical Officers Award Enterprise Agreement 2021.

This up to two-year commitment will allow you to complete your Basic DRANZCOG and your DRANZCOG Advanced qualification. Positions are available to commence in February 2023.

There is significant financial support available for you to either relocate to the Metropolitan area or travel and accommodation costs if you choose to work part-time in your current practice.
