# General Practice Placement Orientation Course

An online course for medical students and junior doctors undertaking general practice placements as part of their university or hospital training.

## What's involved?

The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) GP Placement Orientation Course is designed to help introduce medical students and junior doctors to the general practice setting.

The course features up to six modules (~30-40 minutes each). It can be completed in stages and returned to at any time.

## Why take the course?

This free course will help students and doctors:

- prepare for their placement
- understand the general practice setting using interactive cases and reflection
- maximise their in-practice learning experience
- identify and access useful resources during their placement.



Students/doctors will receive a certificate of completion when they finish the course.
